WHY 30 DAYS OF PRAYER?

This guide has been created to help you join in the 30 Days of Prayer and Fasting with guided daily themes and Scriptures to ground and inspire your prayers.

How Should I Pray?

Over this next 30 days it might be helpful to have some structure to guide your prayer time as you go.

As you come to prayer each day, you may want to follow a simple 4- step process inspired by Jeremiah 6:16a based on the words stand, look, ask, and walk:

STAND- Take a couple of minutes of silence or worship to become aware of the presence of Jesus

LOOK- Pray the prayer, 'Come, Holy Spirit' and read the daily scripture

ASK- Pray the Prayer Prompts for each day with confidence.

WALK- Read through the responding to God section, and act as you feel led.

Jeremiah 6:16a...

HOW SHOULD I PRAY?

3 AREAS OF PRAYER

Over the next 30 days, this Guide will lead you through welcoming the Holy Spirit as you partner with God in Prayer in 3 areas:

- Your personal life (10 days)
- Our Church Community (10 days)
- Our Vineyard family of Churches across the country (10 days)

Sharing Prophetic Words or Pictures.

As we intentionally seek after God and pray over the month of June, we should anticipate that God will move and speak to us.

We believe that prophetic words and pictures can be a source of great encouragement to the entire community during times of prayer, and would love to create space for everyone to share what God lays on their heart.

WHAT ABOUT FASTING?

Dallas Willard explains 'Fasting confirms our utter dependence upon God by finding in Him a source of sustenance beyond food.'

Fasting isn't about pain, but perspective.

It isn't about renouncing the goodness of food, but recognising that spiritual sustenance is only found in God. Fasting focuses our attention upon what God is saying.

How Should I Fast?

Over the next 30 days of Prayer, we would like to invite you to engage in the spiritual discipline of fasting while we pray.

Fasting can be done in a few different ways.

Remove Something: We would like to invite you to remove something from your life for 15 days that will help you focus on Jesus - by removing a distraction we can fix our eyes more fully on Him.

Add Something: We invite you to consider adding something intentionally to your life for 15 days - something that will draw you closer to the heart of God

There need be no sense of religious obligation: simply choose something that works for you- anything that will draw you into a deeper place with Jesus.

FIRST STEPS FOR FASTING

Remove something for 15 days:

- Food - you may choose to fast from food for one day or one meal each week. For more information see *the 'Feasting through Fasting'* resource.

Other ideas for Fasting

Is there a distraction in your day that you could remove?

- Social media
- TV/Netflix
- Negative thought patterns
- Video games

Is there a luxury you could go without?

- Dessert
- Coffee
- Non essential spending/shopping
- Is there a habit you could break?
- Negative thought patterns
- Over-scheduling

FIRST STEPS FOR FASTING

Is there something you could add to your day that deepens your relationship with God and others?

Add something for 15 days:

- Start a Bible reading plan. There are lots of great ones on YouVersion
- Do a daily prayer walk
- Shout a stranger a coffee each day
- Read a new devotional
- Strike up daily conversations with your neighbours/co-workers
- Join a Life group
- Wake up earlier each day to spend time with Jesus
- FaceTime or call someone who is isolated or struggling
- Write letters to a persecuted believer via Open Doors
- Forgive someone who has hurt you
- Start a gratitude journal
- Host a weekly dinner with unsaved friends/family

DAY ONE: YOUR IDENTITY

Scripture

Galatians 4:6-7 – And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, “Abba, Father.” Now you are no longer a slave but God’s own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray that God would open your understanding that you are a child of God, and that you are no longer a slave to sin.

Responding To God

Write out 5 ways that knowing you are a child of God changes your relationship with God.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY TWO: PERSONAL & FAMILY NEEDS

Scripture

Isaiah 44:3 – For I will pour out water to quench your thirst and to irrigate your parched fields. And I will pour out my Spirit on your descendants, and my blessing on your children.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Reflect on areas where you and/or your family have need for refreshing and provision. Pray for those areas.

Responding To God

Write what provision or blessings you requested from the Spirit today.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY THREE: FELLOWSHIP WITH THE SPIRIT

Scripture

2 Corinthians 13:14 (AMP)- The grace (favour and spiritual blessing) of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the presence and fellowship (the communion and sharing together, and participation) in the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen (so be it).

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray, “Father would you show me how to experience the communion, the sharing together, and the participation I can have with the Holy Spirit?”

Responding To God

Using www.biblegateway.com or Bible software, search for “Holy Spirit” and see all the ways that the Spirit is available to help you as a Christian.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY FOUR: FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

Scripture

Galatians 5:22 –But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for the fruit of the Spirit to be present in you and your loved ones today.

Responding To God

From the reading, list the fruits of the Spirit. Next to each fruit, write your name, or the name of a loved one, who needs that fruit in their lives today.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY FIVE: FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT

Scripture

Acts 1:4-5,8 (NLT) – Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, “Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before. John baptised with water, but in just a few days you will be baptised with the Holy Spirit.” “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere – in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Ask God to baptise you with the Holy Spirit, or to refill you with the Holy Spirit, and with power to be God’s witness wherever you go.

Responding To God

Talk with your pastor, mentor or close friend about ways you can nurture your relationship with the Spirit.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY SIX: INCREASING IN LOVE

Scripture

Romans 5:5 – And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray that the Holy Spirit fill your heart with love in the areas in which you lack love.

Responding To God

Ask the Holy Spirit for messages of love for 3 people on your list to love more. Send them.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY SEVEN: BOLDNESS IN FAITH

Scripture

Acts 4:29-30 (NLT) –

And now, O Lord, hear their threats, and give us, your servants, great boldness in preaching your word. Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for God to give you great boldness in sharing your faith, and ask Him to do miracles as you do.

Responding To God

Write down the names of people who God brings to your mind and send them a note, a text, an email, or give them a phone call inviting them to come to church with you.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY EIGHT: HOPE FOR NOW & THE FUTURE

Scripture

Romans 8:23 –

And we believers also groan, even though we have the Holy Spirit within us as a foretaste of future glory, for we long for our bodies to be released from sin and suffering. We, too, wait with eager hope for the day when God will give us our full rights as his adopted children, including the new bodies he has promised us.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for the Kingdom to break in with a gift of hope, for you and your loved ones today.

Responding To God

What would the Lord invite you to “eagerly hope” for today?

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY NINE: PERSEVERANCE

Scripture

2 Corinthians 1:8-11 (NLT) –

We think you ought to know, dear brothers and sisters, about the trouble we went through in the province of Asia. We were crushed and overwhelmed beyond our ability to endure, and we thought we would never live through it. In fact, we expected to die. But as a result, we stopped relying on ourselves and learned to rely only on God, who raises the dead. And he did rescue us from mortal danger, and he will rescue us again. We have placed our confidence in him, and he will continue to rescue us. And you are helping us by praying for us. Then many people will give thanks because God has graciously answered so many prayers for our safety.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray that God would deliver you or someone you know from difficulty, despair, danger, or depression.

Responding To God

If you prayed for someone else, write them a short note and let them know you prayed for them.

DAY TEN: INCREASING JOY

Scripture

Romans 14:17 (AMP) –
[After all] the kingdom of God is not a matter of [getting the] food and drink [one likes], but instead it is righteousness (that state which makes a person acceptable to God) and [heart] peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Ask your heavenly Father for the joy of the Holy Spirit.

Responding To God

Begin to list the blessings that God has poured into your life.

Remember...

This is what the Lord says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls” (Jeremiah 6:16a). Remember as you pray to stand, look, ask, and walk – these are our guide words throughout this prayer adventure.

DAY ELEVEN: OUR LOCAL COMMUNITY

Scripture

Colossians 1:8 – He has told us about the love for others that the Holy Spirit has given you.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for neighbours, co-workers, and others who need an encounter with God today.

Responding To God

How is the Lord inviting you to “show up” in your local community?

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you



DAY TWELVE: HEALING OUR COMMUNITY

Scripture

Mark 16:15-18 (AMP) – And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach and publish openly the good news (the Gospel) to every creature [of the whole human race]. He who believes [who adheres to and trusts in and relies on the Gospel and Him Whom it sets forth] and is baptised will be saved [from the penalty of eternal death]; but he who does not believe [who does not adhere to and trust in and rely on the Gospel and Him Whom it sets forth] will be condemned. And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; they will pick up serpents; and [even] if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will get well.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Ask your Father in Heaven to back up the preaching of the Good News with people being set free from demons, and people who are sick being healed.

Responding To God

If you know someone who is sick, take time to pray for them right now.

DAY THIRTEEN: GROWTH & DISCIPLING

Scripture

John 14:26 — But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative — that is, the Holy Spirit — he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for different generations in your church: Seedlings (Pre school), Seeds (Kindy- Year 4), Grow (Yr 5- 8), Thrive (Year 9- 12), Friday night Youth, Young Adults, Professionals, Parents with young babies, and those older in our community. Pray that each age group will know the Holy Spirit as their Teacher, and grow in depth and passion with their faith.

Responding To God

How can you partner with the Holy Spirit to disciple an age group that is different from your own?

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

SCAN ME



DAY FOURTEEN: THE VULNERABLE & MARGINALISED

Scripture

Matthew 25:37-40 – Then the righteous will answer him, “Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?” The King will reply, “I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.”

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray that God would show you how you can personally engage with the poor and the marginalised in your town or city. Pray for Storehouse and the families that we serve.

Responding To God

Commit to praying for Storehouse regularly, or become involved in giving or practically helping these people in need.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

DAY FIFTEEN: INDIVIDUALS & FAMILIES

Scripture

2 Thessalonians 2:13 – As for us, we can't help but thank God for you, dear brothers and sisters loved by the Lord. We are always thankful that God chose you to be among the first to experience salvation – a salvation that came through the Spirit who makes you holy and through your belief in the truth.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for the Holy Spirit to be poured out on brothers, sisters, families, and individuals in our church.

Responding To God

Write a note to any person or family that God lays on your heart, to tell them you prayed for them today.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

DAY SIXTEEN: EQUIPPING THE SAINTS

Scripture

1 Corinthians 12:6-7 (MSG) – God’s various expressions of power are in action everywhere; but God himself is behind it all. Each person is given something to do that shows who God is: Everyone gets in on it, everyone benefits. All kinds of things are handed out by the Spirit, and to all kinds of people!

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray all the gifts God has given to His local church would find a proper place to be used for the benefit of others.

Responding To God

What passions and gifts has God given and grown within you? Volunteer to serve in an area where you are both gifted and passionate.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

DAY SEVENTEEN: FINANCES & PROVISION

Scripture

1 Corinthians 12:6-7 (MSG) – God’s various expressions of power are in action everywhere; but God himself is behind it all. Each person is given something to do that shows who God is: Everyone gets in on it, everyone benefits. All kinds of things are handed out by the Spirit, and to all kinds of people!

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray this: "Father in Jesus' name, give me a willing and cheerful heart so that I can be generous with my church."

Responding To God

Think about a need, ministry or organisation that our Church community supports. Take this opportunity to ask God how he wants you to give financially to, and through Northridge.

Remember...

DAY EIGHTEEN: ENCOURAGEMENT FOR LEADERS

Scripture

1 Thessalonians 5:12 – Dear brothers and sisters, honour those who are your leaders in the Lord’s work. They work hard among you and give you spiritual guidance.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Ask the Holy Spirit to show you needs, hopes and vision of the pastors, staff, and leaders of your church. Please pray specifically for our Senior Pastors, Rob and Bonnie Giles.

Responding To God

Which leaders in your church would the Lord invite you to encourage with a text today?

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you



DAY NINETEEN: ENCOUNTERING GOD IN WORSHIP

Scripture

Revelation 1:10 – It was the Lord’s Day, and I was worshiping in the Spirit. Suddenly, I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet blast.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Ask the Holy Spirit to release a depth of worship in our church like John had in Revelation.

Responding To God

How would the Lord invite you to take your personal worship deeper: both in quiet times and corporate worship moments? Pray this same prayer for everyone in your congregation.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

DAY TWENTY: UNITY IN OUR CHURCH

Scripture

1 Ephesians 4: 1- 3 – I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Ask the Holy Spirit to give His wisdom and direction to your whole church, and bring a fresh unity and love for Jesus.

Responding To God

Are you holding onto anger, resentment or disappointment with another person? Commit to handing over any of these emotions that you may be feeling, and commit to make peace if God lays someone on your heart.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

DAY 21: PRESENT & FUTURE LEADERSHIP

Scripture

1 Timothy 3:1 – Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. We pray for willing servants who love Jesus and will grow into servant leaders within our communities and our Movement. Pray that God will reveal Himself to children, young adults, and those new to the faith – and call them to follow the Spirit's call into leadership in business, communities, churches, and in the Vineyard Movement in Australia. .

Responding To God

Please pray for Kirk and Nichole Delaney (National Directors), and the board of Vineyard Churches Australia.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

DAY 22: PLANTING KINGDOM MINDED CHURCHES

Scripture

Acts 9:31 – The church then had peace throughout Judea, Galilee, and Samaria, and it became stronger as the believers lived in the fear of the Lord. And with the encouragement of the Holy Spirit, it also grew in numbers.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for the “encouragement of the Holy Spirit” in the Vineyard to plant churches that are effective at the “crossroads” of the cultural intersections each inhabits.

Responding To God

Pray for Chris and Jen Gresham- Britt as they start the journey of planting a new Vineyard church in Toowoomba. Also take some time to pray for Andy and Sarah Starr, and Jono and Tanya Ives as they continue to faithfully partner with Jesus and establish church plants here in our region.

Remember...

Responding To God


Is God leading you to commit to praying and intercede for a specific country or people group?

DAY 24: CHILDREN IN OUR MOVEMENT

Scripture

Luke 18:16 –But Jesus called the children to him and said, “Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. The Kingdom of God is alive and well in the tender hearts of children. Pray that God’s love would be anchored so deeply in the little ones that they will remain close to Him now and throughout their whole lives.

Responding To God

Pray for direction and inspiration for Kids Pastors within Vineyard Australia. Ask the Spirit to highlight how you may have disregarded “the little children,” and how God uses them in His Kingdom. Notice the children around you, and how the Lord is inviting you to be one who affirms their identity as children of God.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

DAY 25: YOUTH IN OUR MOVEMENT

Scripture

Acts 2:17a – “In the last days,” God says, “I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams.”

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. It seems our culture seeks to hijack the vigour and passion of youth from their purposes in God’s Kingdom to “the kingdom of this world.” Pray that our Youth will grow in a Godly understanding of their identity in Christ. Pray for the Spirit to be poured out on the youth in your church and surrounding community in powerful, life-changing ways.

Responding To God

Ask the Spirit to highlight the middle schoolers and teenagers around you. Notice how the Lord is inviting you to get to know them and about their lives, and even to listen to their thoughts about God.

Remember...

To be listening...Scan and share any words or pictures that the Lord gives you

SCAN ME



DAY 26: YOUNG ADULTS IN OUR MOVEMENT

Scripture

Isaiah 40:31 – But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Young adults often can experience crises of faith and as they are tempted by cultural voices that lead them astray. Pray for the young adults in your family, church, and in the Vineyard movement to “know the Lord’s voice” above all others – and to be empowered to know God’s love for them as they face “adulthood” in today’s world.

Responding To God

Ask the Spirit to give you faith for the young adults around you (especially if you are one!), and to fill you with a prayerful confidence that there is a mighty future for these women and men in God’s Kingdom.

DAY 27: OLDER ADULTS & FAMILIES IN OUR MOVEMENT

Scripture

Romans 8:37-39 – No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. God's love is for all generations in all seasons of life. Pray that people and families you know, young and old, will know God's love for them, and that knowing God's love will propel them toward health and purpose in all seasons of their lives.

Responding To God

Ask the Spirit to highlight attitudes and judgmental thoughts you may have toward those of older/different generations than you. Notice how the Lord is inviting you to know He can, and does work in and through anyone at any age in any place.

DAY 28: SAGES & RETIRED PEOPLE

Scripture

Job 12:12 –Is not wisdom found among the aged? Does not long life bring understanding?

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. The world around us today values the energy of youth, and has not learned to value those who are long in years and experience. Pray for those of retirement age, especially pastors and faithful servants, to experience God's love and purpose in their twilight years.

Responding To God

How might the Lord be inviting you to have an open mind about the twilight years of your own life, the lives of aging family, or older people in your community?

DAY 29: IMPACT IN CITIES & TOWNS

Scripture

Romans 12:1b-2a (MSG) – Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out.

Prayer Prompt

Come, Holy Spirit. Pray for the Spirit to highlight areas opportunities where our Church can move “outside the walls” to serve alongside neighbourhood, town, and city officials to see improvement and community growth in your areas. Ask for signs and wonders to occur through our church into the local community.

Responding To God

Take a moment to remember the groups – sports teams, civic associations, business connections - of which you are a part. Notice how the Lord is inviting you to partner with what He is doing in and through these groups. Take risks with Jesus!

Pray earnestly and fervently for this on this final day of our 30 day prayer journey. Pray For Vineyard Australia churches. COME, HOLY SPIRIT.

Responding To God

Notice how the Lord has made a new space in you to pray, “Come, Holy Spirit” in all aspects of your daily life. Celebrate the Spirit’s work in your heart, and anticipate His presence with you always.
